FALL CELEBRATION and PARADE AT WELCH...On Friday, October 26th, we will have our Fall Celebrations at Welch! At 2:10 PM (weather permitting) students will parade around the school. Students will exit the building through door #8 (gym door) and parade around the outside of the building, entering the building through door #4 (playground door). Teachers and staff walk with the students and provide supervision. Parents are invited to watch the parade from the back playground area as each class walks around the building. If the parade is cancelled due to weather, we will send out an email and/or phone call by 1:00 p.m.

From 2:45 – 3:15 PM, the students will participate in a Fall Celebration, which will include a craft and games.

As we want to ensure the safety of all students during this celebration and maintain an environment conducive to learning the day of the celebration, we are asking that students follow the rules below:

- Students are not to wear costumes to school at the beginning of the day; time will be provided prior to the parade for students to change into their costume. Costumes MUST be able to be put on in the classroom – no students will be allowed to go to the bathroom to change into a costume.
- Parents should assist their child/ren in making appropriate decisions about what students wear for costumes, ensuring that costumes are school appropriate and meet all of the District 204 Dress Code Guidelines. Please note that masks are not permitted at school.
- Please keep play weapons at home. Sharp objects (i.e. wooden swords) may NOT be part of any costume, as we want to ensure all students' safety.


- Only those volunteers helping with room parties will be allowed into the building during the celebration. As a reminder, party volunteers will need to check in the office with a valid ID. All volunteers should have a valid ID with them the day of the party, even if they have been scanned in Raptor this year. This is a very busy day in the office and we appreciate your patience. Past practice allowed for students to go home with parents at the conclusion of the celebrations; please note that we will not be releasing students at the end of the celebrations this year. We ask that students meet their parents at their typical dismissal spot at 3:35 PM.
- Students not participating in the Halloween Parade or Fall Celebration on the basis of religious beliefs or family choice will be supervised and provided an alternate activity during this time. To ensure we have materials and plans for this, we ask that you contact Sarah Nowak by Wednesday, October 24th if your child(ren) will not be participating the parade and/or Fall Celebration.


- Scheduling closes on October 26th at 4 pm.

1. From the HAC Home Page, click on School Links




2. Click on PowerPTC - Online Conference Scheduler
