


Try a Little Kindness

These hilarious cartoon animals show how to be kind. Each page features a different way to be a good person, like using proper manners, telling someone they are special, or sharing a treat!




Maxi the Little Taxi (author Elizabeth Upton, illustrator Henry Cole)


I Know a Wee Piggy (author Kim Norman, illustrator Henry Cole)


Unspoken: A Story from the Underground Railroad
