





HEALTH SERVICES

- + **Physicals:** All incoming 6th grade students and new students to the district must complete a physical exam prior to the beginning of the school year.
- + **Health History:** Complete the “health history” located on the top portion of the back page on the physical form. Also complete the **White Medical Card** for the health office emergency numbers.
- + **Immunizations:** Students entering 6th grade must show proof of receiving the **Meningococcal** conjugate vaccine.
- + **Dental:** Students entering 6th grade are required to present proof of a dental exam.
- + **7th and 8th Grade Students:** Required to have a current physical in order to **try out** for any interscholastic sport.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

ADVISORY

- + Occurs once a week on Wednesdays
- + Allows teachers to connect with students and provide both academic and non-academic support
- + Common Sense Lessons/Presentations (cyber-bullying, safe online talk, reality of digital media)
- + Some of the many learning outcomes include: organization, time management, working cooperatively, diversity, equity, anti-bullying strategies, team building, and personal academic and social goals.
- + Allows student services members to run groups based on student needs survey.



ADVISORY

Teaching Tolerance's *Perspectives for a Diverse America* is a literacy-based curriculum that marries anti-bias social justice content with the rigor of the Common Core and SEL State Standards.

- + Identity - Students will understand the multiple facets of their identities, know where those traits come from, and feel comfortable being themselves in a diversity of settings.
- + Diversity - Students will recognize the diversity of people in the world, be able to identify differences and commonalities, express interest in the lived experiences of others and develop genuine connections with others.
- + Justice & Action - Students will be aware of bias and injustice, both individual and systemic, will understand the short and long-term impact of injustice, and will know about those who have fought for more fairness and justice in our world. Students will feel confident that they can make a difference in society and will commit to taking action against bias and injustice even when it is not popular or easy.
