- Room 204 – *Tech focus on Google Classroom and common apps used in the classroom*

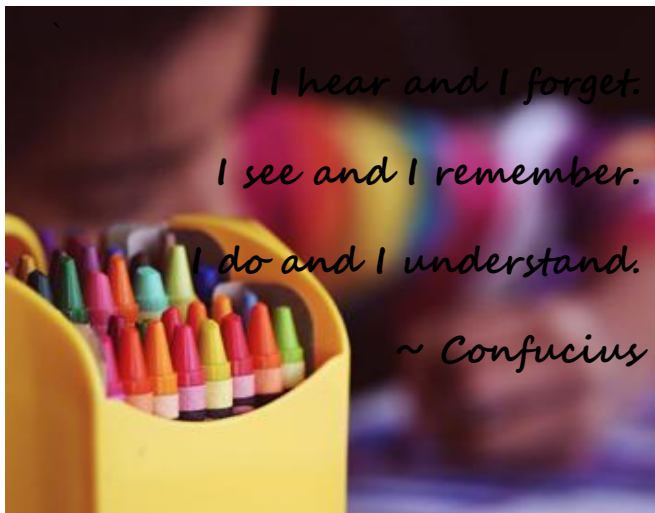
## CURRICULUM EXPLORATION

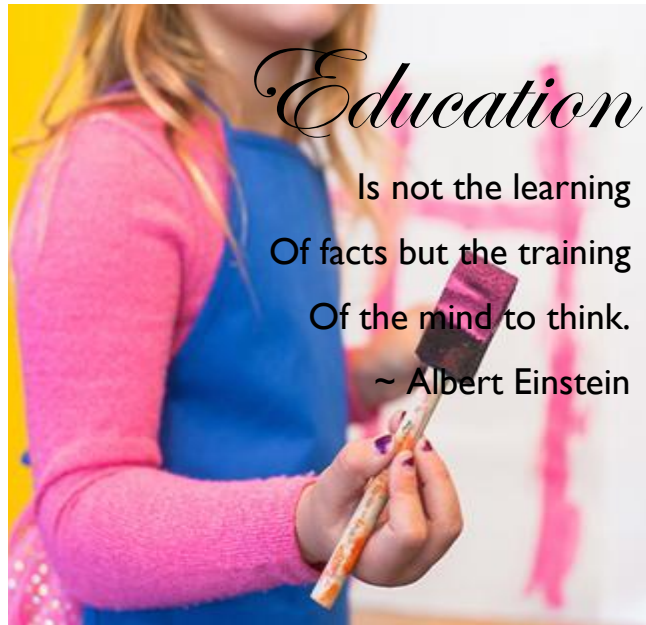
## Curriculum Night 2019

The schedule for our 2019 Curriculum Night is as follows:

## Grade Level Presentations

Grade level teachers will present in their classrooms twice; once at 6:30pm and again at 7:30pm. The presentations are identical which allows parents to attend different grade levels if necessary. Teachers will share curricular units for English Language Arts, Math, Social Emotional Learning, Social Studies and Science. In addition, the teachers will share expectations for their classrooms and answer questions if needed.



## KINDERGARTEN

Each classroom will have the following centers to explore:

- *Jolly Phonics* – books, games, sound strip, work page, etc.
- *Second Step* – listening posters, lesson cards, attentoscope, vocab lists, puppets, etc.
- *Math* – manipulatives, rekenrak/ten frame cards, number bond, anchor charts, games.
- *ELA* – trade books for Unit 1, Word Wall Word path game, blending cards, etc.

## FIRST GRADE

Each classroom will share the following:

- *Second Step* – listening posters, lesson cards, vocab lists, puppets, etc.
