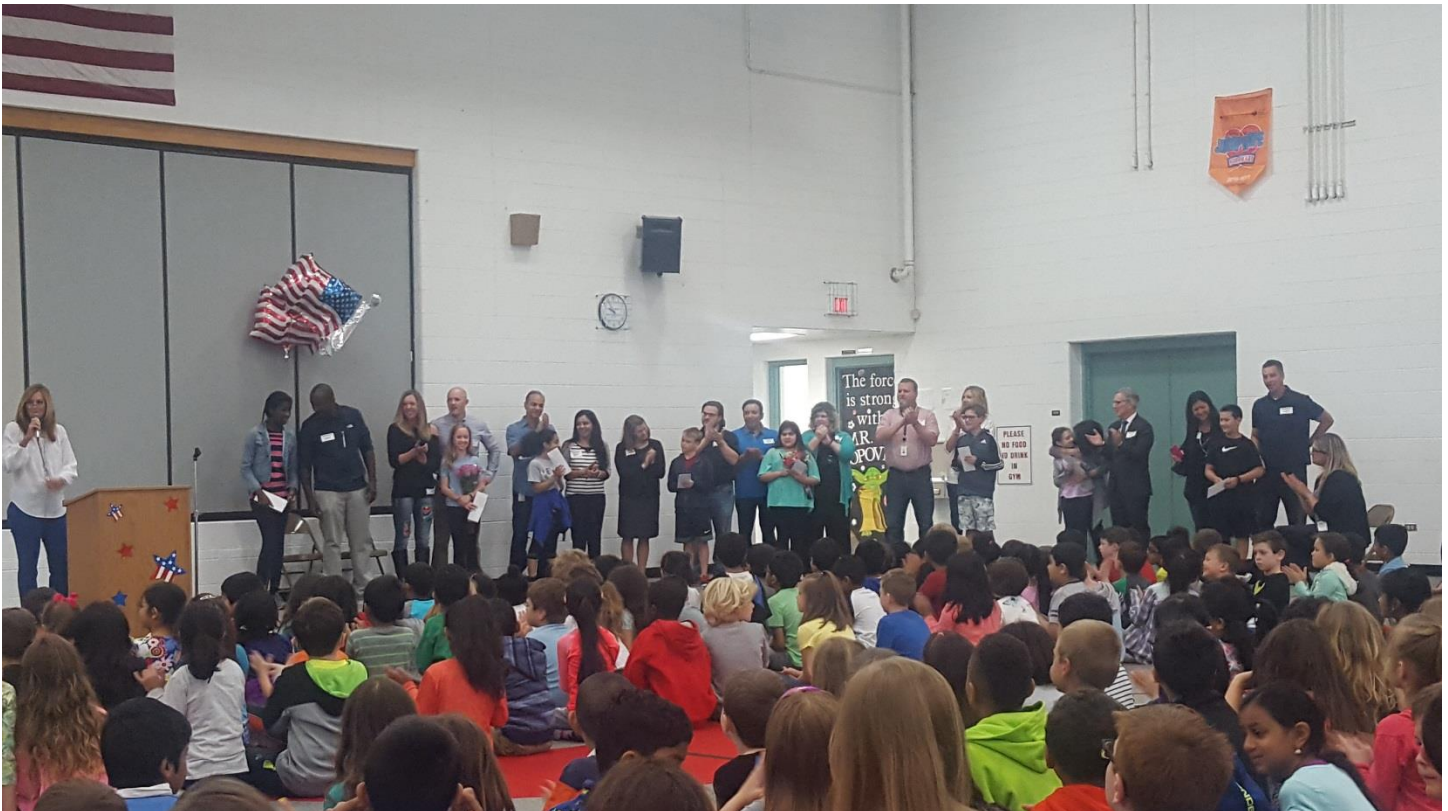




# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Citizenship Awards
