Of all the things that come along with starting kindergarten, lunch seems to be one that causes the most butterflies among students. Parents and students are invited to bring a sack lunch and learn more about the school and have some questions answered on Thursday, August 17th from 11:30 a.m - 12:15 p.m. . This is a great opportunity for the students to meet fellow White Tigers, as well as help make everyone feel comfortable

with the school and excited about starting the school year. This event is for Welch students and their parents only; we ask that siblings do not attend.

Meet and Greet

Please join us for a Meet and Greet on Monday, August 21st from 2:00 - 3:00 PM. The Meet and Greet will be held in the Welch classrooms . This is an opportunity for students and teachers to introduce themselves to one another. To assist in everyone entering the building in a prompt fashion, we ask that families use the following doors:

Kindergarten - Door #3 (front east side of the building)

First Grade - Door #1 (main entrance)

Second Grade - Door #1 (main entrance)

Third Grade - Door #5 (rear of the building by the playground)

Fourth Grade - Door #2 (front east side of the building)

Fifth Grade - Door #7 (west side of the building by the parking lot and bike rack)

First Day Attendance for Kindergarten Students

Kindergarteners and their parents will attend a 30 minute small group session in their classroom on the first day of school, August 24th. This is an opportunity for you and your child to meet his or her teacher and other children in the class. Please plan your first day attendance based on the schedule below. Beginning August 25th, kindergarteners will attend school from 9:05 a.m.-3:35 p.m, except for Wednesdays, when attendance hours are from 9:15 a.m. - 3:35 p.m.

Curriculum Night

Please mark your calendars for this fall's Curriculum Night. This evening is designed to allow parents the opportunity to better get to know their child's teacher and hear about the curriculum designed for their child's grade level. Curriculum night will be held on Wednesday, September 13th, for all grade levels. Each grade level has two identical sessions from which to choose.

First Session: 6:00-6:30 p.m

Second Session: 6:45-7:15 p.m.

Please note that this evening is for **PARENTS ONLY**. Welch students and siblings are not invited to this important night for parents.

Wednesday Late Start

The students' school day will have a slightly delayed start on each Wednesday of the school year. On Wednesdays, school will begin at 9:15 a.m., instead of 9:05 a.m. This delayed start allows for teachers to learn and plan together on Wednesday mornings for a longer period of time. Bus pick-up on Wednesday mornings will be ten minutes later than your child's regularly scheduled morning pick-up time. If your child does not ride a bus to school, and you are unable to make arrangements for your child to arrive at 9:05 a.m. on Wednesday mornings, your child will be able to arrive at school at the regular time, 8:50 a.m., and he/she will read quietly in the hallway until arrival begins at 9:05 a.m. This silent reading time will be supervised by Welch staff members. On Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, school will begin at 9:05 a.m. This means children are expected to be in their classrooms to start their day by 9:05. Dismissal, all five days of the week will be at 3:35 p.m.

Attendance and Early Dismissals

If your child will be absent on any day during the school year, it is critical for you to report the absence to the school attendance line at (630) 428-7200 **ext 3**. Please remember to describe the nature of your student's absence. All absences should be reported prior to the beginning of the school day. Thank you. If your child will be absent for 5 or more days a doctor's note is required upon returning to school. To ensure that we have all staff available to assist with dismissal and to ensure that our bus lanes are clear, we ask that if you need to pick up your child early from school that you do so before 3:10 PM. Whenever you pick up your child(ren) early from school please note that we will call them down once you arrive to ensure they don't miss any additional time from their classroom. Feel free to build in a few extra pick up minutes when planning for doctor appointments, etc.

Arrival and Dismissal

If your student is a WALKER, they will be exiting the building from doors #2/#3 (FRONT WALKERS) or doors #4/#5 (BACK WALKERS) only at 3:35 PM. Parents are invited to legally park on one of the streets and meet their student(s) at doors #2/#3 or doors #4/#5 if you choose not to use the car pick-up line.

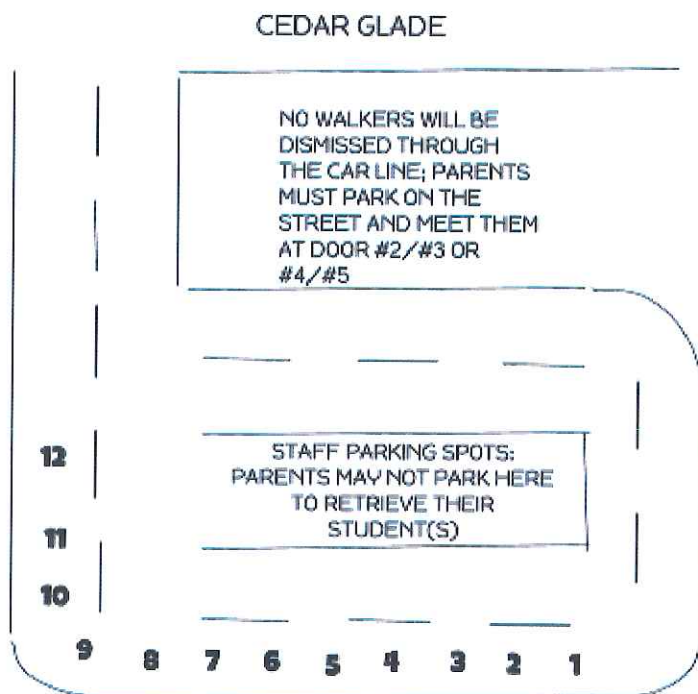
A WALKER is any student who is not picked up in the car line or bus rider. Please note that students will only be dismissed through Door #8 if their ride is picking them up in the car line.

If your student is a CAR RIDER please follow these procedures:

- Parents should enter the parking lot off of Cedar Glade.
- Parents should have their student(s) name displayed in the dash or window of their car. Car tags will be passed out at Meet and Greet. If you need additional tags, please email Sarah Nowak (sarah_nowak@ipsd.org) or Sherry Fredericks

(sherry.fredericks@ipsd.org) and we will ensure that you receive one as soon as possible.

- Staff will direct parents to one of the assigned loading spots, which will be identified with large numbered signs.
- Staff will assist students in locating their car at the specified loading spot. It is important that cars have the tags clearly displayed to ensure students locate their car quickly.
- Parents must stay in their car; staff will assist students as needed.
- As cars load and exit the lot, parents should move forward to the first available loading spot. For example, if you are parked in spot 5 waiting for your student(s) and the cars from spots 3 and 4 leave, you will be asked to move up to loading spot 3.

Lunch and Recess

School lunch money can be dropped in the metal lock box outside the main office in an envelope or baggie with your child's name, grade, and teacher on it at anytime. It can also be paid online via Pushcoin. Pushcoin is a new electronic payment system.

Lunch is 20 minutes long and recess is 15 minutes. Students will eat first and then go outside for recess. The lunch/recess periods for the 2017 - 2018 school year are as follows:

Kindergarten - 11:40 a.m. - 12:15 p.m.

First Grade - 12:05 p.m. - 12:40 p.m.

Second Grade - 12:55 p.m - 1:30 p.m.

Third Grade - 11:15 a.m. - 11:40 a.m.
Fourth Grade - 10:50 a.m. - 11:25 a.m.
Fifth Grade - 12:30 p.m. - 1:05 p.m.

Lunch is an important component of every student's school day. It is a time for students to relax and interact with peers. As a special treat, Welch parents are invited to come in and eat lunch with their student(s) **one time** a year on their birthday, half birthday, or a day of their choosing; we will have a separate table in the lunchroom for students and their parent(s) to sit at while celebrating. Please note that this special lunch is for the birthday student and their parents/guardians **only**. Younger siblings are unable to attend this special lunch. We do ask that visiting parents leave after lunch rather than going out for recess. We know this is a valuable "kid time" for our students.

Parents are always welcome to drop off lunch for their child(ren); however, we ask that parents do **NOT** bring lunches for other children. This presents a problem for the school staff in that we do not know that other parents have approved the lunch. In addition, other children may feel excluded. There is a special lunch bin by the "I Forgot" bins that our lunchroom supervisors check prior to each lunch period and deliver to the students.

Classroom snacks

Each classroom has a time during the day to enjoy a **HEALTHY** snack. We ask that the snack be **NUT** free. Suggested snacks include fresh fruits and vegetables, crackers, granola bars, pretzels, and goldfish. Please don't send candy, cookies, cakes, chips, pudding, soda, and other dessert-like items.

"I Forgot" Bins

In an effort to limit the number of interruptions within classrooms, we ask that the "I Forgot" bins located in the main entrance of Welch be used to deliver any items for students. Each grade level has a bin and students and staff check these periodically throughout the day. Items that may need more attention (i.e. glasses) should be dropped off in the office so we can ensure they are promptly delivered to classrooms.

Bus Routes

Bus route information will be available in the Home Access Center home page no later than August 15th. Please know that the start of each school year brings with it the potential for some overcrowding on buses. During the first few weeks of school, especially on high school bus routes, rider counts fluctuate as students explore their various methods of transport. We ask for your patience as bus drivers and school administrators take daily head counts of high volume routes and adjustments are made to route assignments. Please allow at least 10 minutes for a late bus before calling your school. Please note that students are not able to ride home on a bus other than what they are assigned.
