



2017-2018 Middle School Chromebook Replacement Costs

These portions of the Middle School 1:1 Handbook address Lost/Stolen/Damaged Chromebooks.

- **Lost/Stolen/Damaged Chromebooks:**

Many families may have questions about what they would need to pay if a student 1:1 device is damaged, lost, or stolen. Normally, as with textbooks, a student would be charged a fine to cover the actual repair or replacement costs for school-issued materials.

- **Repair and/or Replacement Costs:**

Loss, theft, or damage of a device must be reported to school officials as soon as feasible. School administrators and Technology staff will assess the situation and confirm costs to be assessed to the student/parent.

Below are the specific costs for Chromebook repairs and replacement:

● Bezel	\$18.00
● Top Cover	\$28.00
● Bottom Cover	\$30.00
● Hinge Set	\$15.00
● Keyboard & Touchpad	\$46.00
● Motherboard	\$90.00
● AC Charger	\$28.00
● DC Jack	\$15.00
● Full Replacement	\$126.00
● Broken or Missing MaxCase	\$12.00
● Asset Tag Replacement	\$2.00
