SPRING RECREATIONAL SOCCER

Spring Outdoor Soccer for 1st-8th grade—All skill levels are invited to participate. There is a boys league and a girls league. A 6-game season (April 15—May 20) plays on Saturdays with one practice per week scheduled by the coach. **This program includes 4 team technical/tactical training sessions with a professional trainer.** Teams are coached by parent volunteers.

Kindergarten Soccer for 5-6 yr olds—WAA’s Pro-Academy Kindergarten program has now joined Team Chicago’s Pro-Academy line-up of soccer. This 6-week beginning level program incorporates a skills clinic AND small sided game each week. Coaches work with WAA professional trainers each Saturday. **Volunteer coaches needed!**

COMPETITIVE BASEBALL

Minors, Majors, & Ponies—Advanced program for competitive baseball players ages 9 to 14 years old (as of May 1, 2017). Teams are organized using a tryout and draft process. All new *and returning* players **MUST** be pre-registered to tryout or to reserve returning team placement. **Pre-registration fee due by April 1– \$10.**

SUMMER BASEBALL

The **Recreational T-Ball & Baseball program** is for youth currently in **Kindergarten** (or K in Fall 2017) **through 8th grade**. The 12-game season (2 games/week) starts after Memorial Day and ends mid-July. Games are played weekday evenings and Saturdays on local fields. Coaches will schedule a weekly practice. Practices start in mid-May. An All-Star Game Day is included for 2nd grade & up.

SUMMER SOFTBALL

The **Recreational Softball program** is for girls in **1st grade through 8th grade**. The 12-game season starts after Memorial Day and ends mid-July. Games are played weekday evenings and Saturdays on local fields. Coaches will schedule a weekly practice. Practices start in mid-May. An all-star game is included for grades 5th – 8th. **Girls pre-K-K should register for T-ball.**

FALL FLAG FOOTBALL

Non-contact football for 1st – 8th graders, played in a safe and fun atmosphere. Each league has a player combine (orientation, evaluation, and equipment handout), team practices and games. Games are played on Saturdays and coaches will schedule one practice during the week. All teams play an 8-game regular season schedule beginning in late August. The season will complete with a single elimination tournament culminating in the Bowl Championship Game for each Division.
