EXPLORER CAMP

Kindergarten to Grade 6

Sign-in and Sign-out

All campers must be signed in and out by a parent or guardian each day. The registration table is located in the Continuing Education Office, Student Resource Center (SRC), Room 1110.

Supervised Play

Before and after the interactive academic class time, campers are supervised by youth aides. Explorer Camp youth aides are young adults, age 18 or over, who are trained COD staff. During supervised play, campers engage in fun enrichment activities, including games, books, Legos, drawing, pingpong and movies.

Interactive Class

Class topics are based upon the theme of the week and are led by licensed teachers. Topics are academic, engaging and—most of all—fun!

Lunch

Students may bring a sack lunch or purchase in the cafeteria. A cafeteria lunch plan will be available for summer 2017. Please see site supervisor for pricing and details. Campers are supervised by youth aides throughout the lunch break, including the walk to and from the cafeteria.

Art

The art classes are taught by a licensed teacher and projects align with the topic of the week. Campers will bring home creative, colorful projects throughout the summer!

Physical Activity

After lunch, campers are guided through physical activities and games by a youth aide. When weather permits, campers will play in outdoor spaces. During inclement weather, physical activity time will move inside.

T-Shirts and Water Bottles

All campers are required to wear the provided camp t-shirt. Each camper is issued a new t-shirt every Monday, if needed. Each camper receives an Explorer Camp water bottle to be used for the duration of camp.
