



Earth Week Naperville 2020 Climate Action Artwork Challenge

Earth Week Naperville will be celebrated in collaboration with the 50th year of Earth Day throughout the months of April and May. The Earth Day Fair will be Sunday, April 19 at the Fort Hill Activity Center, 20 Fort Hill Drive, Naperville, IL.

The Earth Week Naperville Planning Committee is excited to reach out to students of the Naperville area, grades K-12, to design and create artwork to publicize the events. The selected artwork will be printed on Earth Week Naperville publications, posters, flyers and on the Earth Week Naperville website. The deadline for submitting a design/artwork is Wednesday, April 15.

Theme:

The theme of Earth Day 2020 is Climate Action. Submissions should have their own original name/theme. Submitters are encouraged to create an artistic design to highlight the role they feel they have in protecting the earth. Thought should be given to how your artwork can bring attention to and impact our environment. The committee is open to all interpretations and ideas for the theme.

Artwork Guidelines:

- * The submission can be created by hand or with a computer and needs to appeal to a broad audience.
- * The submission should not include any text.
- * There are no size requirements.
- * The submission must be flat; no 3-dimensional submissions.
- * There are no color limitations or restrictions. Keep in mind simple, bold designs are best. The more complicated a design, the more difficult it is to transfer.
- * The submission must be original in concept and not violate U.S. Copyright Law.

Media & Recognition:

- * The Earth Week Naperville Committee will select the winning artwork based upon originality, creativity, and content.
- * The submission selected may be reproduced in color or black and white for advertising. The Earth Week Naperville Committee reserves the right to make modifications to the design to accommodate the addition of logos, text about the event, etc.
- * The artist will be recognized in the Earth Week Naperville program for 2021 and invited to the City of Naperville's Proclamation reading at a City Council Meeting. The Naperville Park District's Resolution will be approved at their board meeting prior to event.

Artwork will become property of the Earth Week Naperville Committee and will be returned to the artist upon request within 30 days after April 22, 2021.

Submission Guidelines:

- * Print the student's full name, grade and school legibly on the back of the artwork.
- * All artwork must be original, 2-dimensional and include an artist statement describing the artwork.
- * Submission may come directly from the student or from the art teacher at their school.
- * Only artwork submitted by the deadline will be considered.
- * **Deadline is Wednesday, April 15, 2020.**
