KEYNOTE SPEAKER: Erin Merryn

For six years of her childhood, Erin was sexually abused keeping her secret locked away in her childhood diary. Since 2004, Erin has traveled across America sharing her triumph over a childhood of sexual abuse and also testifying to lawmakers to pass Erin's Law. As of January 2020, Erin's Law has passed in 37 states, including her home state of Illinois. A voice once ashamed to tell anyone what happened behind closed doors has now opened that door to the world to expose a silent epidemic in an unstoppable crusade to put a face and voice on sexual abuse.
