8th Grade Dance

- There will be an 8th grade dance on Tuesday, May 31st from 6:30PM-8:30PM sponsored in cooperation with Granger and the PTA. This is not a formal dance or a date dance. Only current Granger 8th graders who are in good standing academically and behaviorally are eligible to attend. Dress code is dress/casual. Should the need arise due to inappropriate behavior, a student may be disallowed to participate in the dance. More detailed information will be coming in May.
