



Dr. Rubin's Mini Medical School for High School Students

Dr. Rubin's Mini-Medical School is a community service program created in 2004. Our programs are designed to encourage motivated high school students to become physicians and surgeons. Applications for our Mini Medical School for High School Students are now available on our website: www.MinimMedicalSchool.com.

The Mini Medical School for High School Students Program is a competitive program. Due to the pandemic, we have adapted our program to provide approximately 12 hours of online lectures that will stream to your home computer. Students will start streaming the first week of January and have 6 weeks to view the ~12 hours of lecture. Students will then meet in small pods of 8-10 students with 2 teaching assistants, who will provide you oversight and guidance as you learn and perform the clinical and procedural skills most medical students learn in the 2nd and 3rd years of medical school. These pods will meet for a total of 8 hours divided in half for two 4 hour sessions at the Naperville Campus of Northern Illinois University on Saturdays Feb 5 & 19th or Sundays Feb 6 & 20th. Students will be required to wear a mask and be fully immunized against COVID. In addition on the day of the program, they will have to pass a temperature and verbal screen for COVID. Students unable to attend are being offered a totally virtual experience by assigning a student Teaching Assistant who will mentor you student during the hands on project times through the use of zoom or facetime.

Admission to this program is competitive. There is no fee to apply. This program is appropriate for advanced sophomores, juniors and senior students. The fee for the program which includes all medical and surgical supplies and refreshments is \$450 payable in check to Dr. Rubin's Mini Med School NFP. This year we are requiring an online application, parent consent and counselor form. Teacher recommendations are optional due to the pandemic. Applications will be processed as they are received. Student finalists will be offered an interview. The deadline for us to receive a complete application is **November 8, 2021**. Please go online to our website for more details.
